It's nice to have carpets that remain clean and mud-free, which is why we request one pair of indoor shoes, which remain at school. Appropriate outdoor clothing is essential because we go outdoors under most weather conditions.

The phase-in week is a special time for students. Please plan on letting them have the pleasure of bringing their supplies into school on their special first day.
